

**Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas Air Quality Class I Operating Permit Renewal
and Amendment to Previously Issued Construction Approvals**

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality operating permit renewal and amending previously issued construction approval. Robbie Manufacturing, Inc. has applied for a Class I operating permit renewal in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-510 et al. The purpose of a Class I permit is to identify the sources and types of regulated air pollutants emitted from the facility; the emission limitations, standards and requirements applicable to each source; and the monitoring, record keeping and reporting requirements applicable to each source as of the effective date of permit issuance. Notice is also given that certain requirements in the construction approval dated May 8, 1987, March 12, 1991, October 29, 1993, and October 21, 1994 are being modified by a modification of approval conditions.

Robbie Manufacturing, Inc., 10810 Mid-America Avenue, Lenexa, Kansas 66219, owns and operates a flexographic printing facility located at 10810 Mid-America Avenue, Lenexa, Kansas 66219.

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, all information relied upon during the permit application review process, and a copy of the modification of approval conditions are available for a 30 day public review during normal business hours at the KDHE, Bureau of Air and Radiation (BAR), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1366. Also a copy of the proposed permit only can be reviewed at the Johnson County Environmental Department, 11180 Thompson Avenue, Lenexa, Kansas 66219. To obtain or review either document, contact Rasha Allen (785) 296-1693 at the central office of the KDHE, and review of the proposed permit only, contact Mike Boothe (913) 492-0402 at the Johnson County Environmental Department. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

Direct written comments or questions regarding the documents to Rasha Allen, KDHE, BAR, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1366, (785) 296-1693. In order to be considered in formulating final document decisions written comments must be received no later than the close of business on December 12, 2005.

A person may request a public hearing be held on proposed documents. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Ms. Christy Thurman, BAR, KDHE, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1366, no later than the close of business on in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has a 45-day review period, which will start concurrently with the 30-day public comment period, within which to object to the proposed permit. If the USEPA has not objected in writing to the issuance of the permit within the 45-day review period, any person may petition the administrator of the USEPA to review the permit. The 60-day public petition period will directly follow the USEPA 45 day review period. Interested parties may contact KDHE to determine if the USEPA 45-day review period has been waived.

Any such petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the public comment period provided for in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates that it was impracticable to raise such objections within such period, or unless the grounds for such objection arose after such period.
